The purpose of the North Dakota Association for Home Care (NDAHC) is to encourage high quality, coordinated, comprehensive home health care for the citizens of our state.

Continued member support is **crucial** to the Home Care profession so that we may continue to focus on expanding Home Care funding. In 2007 we received a significant increase in personal care services reimbursement rates and in 2009, we were given a 1 dollar wage and benefit pass-through for in-home care providers and a 6% inflationary increase in reimbursement rates each year of the biennium for both Medical Assistance and Personal Care Services. Although we have made strides this past Legislative session, there is more to do.

NDAHC is also your agency's link to a network of other home care providers and current information within the industry. Home care continues to be the preferred choice of long term care for seniors and the chronically ill and it is important we continue to provide valuable services and advocate for the dignity and independence of those in need of health care.
